About Me

I live either close to water or far in the woods. At the first feel of ice on my belly, activates my winter fluid. During winter my antifreeze proteins freeze my body but let's my blood flow freely without a heartbeat. Ice crystals in my blood, allows me to live during the winter. 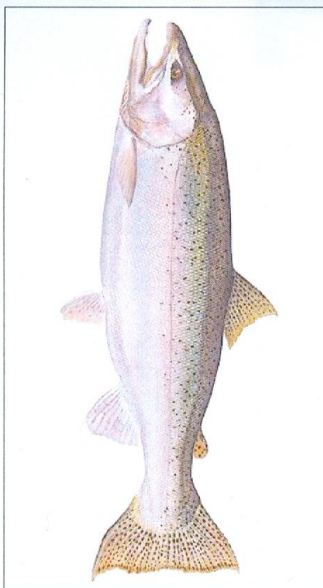

Information

I am a Rainbow trout aka steelhead (*Oncorhynchus mykiss*)
I live all across America and in the Pacific Ocean

About Me

I get my name from the colors on my side. And I get the steelhead name from my steel-gray head.

I can exceed to 30 inches (750mm) and weight 15 lbs (6.8kg)

I eat waterfleas and aquatic insects like caddisflies, mayflies, midges, snail, leeches, fish eggs, sideswimmers and algae.

I am eaten by sculpins, smallmouth bass, larger trout, kingfishers, herons, eagles, osprey, otters, otters and humans.

And I adapt to the winter by going to lakes and living deep from the ice at the surface.

Interests

I can live in fresh and salt water near the coastlines

I can live from 3-4 years

During the early springs I go up stream to spawn and I live and grow for 2-3 years in stream and creeks before going downstream to the lake.

Activities

I survive by living deep in lakes and I eat by attacking my prey that like to hang around under the surface of the ice.

And during the winter I swim, eat and fight other trout for territory in the water and for food.
