Please, if you can, donate any items from the attached list. Items can be brought in to the High School - kids can bring them right to my room (207) between Friday, 9/16 and Tuesday, 9/20. I'd like to deliver the items to the distribution center on Tuesday or Wednesday after school.

Flood Relief Items Needed:

- Paper products (towels, toilet paper, plates, cups)
- Personal care items (shampoo, soap, hand sanitizer, razors, toothpaste and toothbrushes, diapers, deodorant)
- Band-aids & antibiotic ointment
- Lysol wipes, bleach, sponges, dish liquid, laundry detergent
- Blankets & pillows
- Batteries & flashlights
- Towels & washcloths
- Rubber gloves, buckets, garbage bags, masks, mops
- School supplies (all – notebooks, paper, pens, pencils, erasers, crayons, etc.)
- Any non-perishable food items (cereal, canned fruit, mac & cheese, pasta, soup, coffee, filters, sugar, creamer, etc.)

NOT NEEDED: They are doing ok with clothes donations and are getting bottled water from the county. Everything else is needed!
